

PACKING LIST FOR DESTINATION MICRO-WEDDINGS

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NOTE: if traveling by air, many airlines will allow you to carry-on dresses and suits and will hang them in the first-class cabins. Call your airline ahead to confirm. Also, carry-on any expensive and/or sentimental items.

TIPS:

- If you are working with a planner, they will likely bring an emergency supply kits with hair pins, BandAids, scissors, etc. Also, check with your planner on items they might bring (i.e. Wendee brings cake stands, cutting knives.).
- Sometimes planners will allow you to ship items to them. If you do this, ship around a month out (too far runs the risk of getting lost/damaged), carefully pack the items, and clearly label the outside of the box with your names and wedding date. Provide tracking numbers.
- To shake-out wrinkles in any attire from travel, steam the bathroom by running a hot shower. When the room is steamy, hang your attire/dress in the room.

PERSONAL ATTIRE

- Dress/s and suits
- Shoes
- Accessories (ties, socks, tote bags)
- Jewelry, glasses

TRAVEL ESSENTIALS: SAVE ON PHONES TOO!

- Passports, and/or government-issued identification
- Travel confirmations (saved on phone too) like car & hotel
- Boarding passes
- Visas and/or copies of birth certificates (if necessary)
- Travel and/or wedding insurance

PERSONAL PRODUCTS

- Makeup, hair care, nail care, facial care, etc.
- Razor and shaving cream
- Sunscreen, chapstick, toothbrush/paste, deodorant
- NOTE: If your are hiking professional makeup artists, hairstylists and barbers, you won't need a bunch of extra supplies - travel light!

OTHER MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Phone and charger
- Laptop/iPad and charger

OTHER WEDDING ATTIRE

- Wedding rings
- Veils or hair accessories
- Pocket squares, watch, cufflinks, etc.
- Special perfume
- Garter, robes, jackets, shawls, etc.

WEDDING NECESSITIES & DETAILS

- Copies of invitations
- Vow books, vows script
- Special gifts to attendants, parents
- Special ceremony items (sand ceremony, wine, ties, etc.)
- Guest book (if applicable)
- DIY decor and/or favors (though, we recommend working with a local florist who will supply and setup)

DESTINATION-SPECIFIC

- Swim wear and sun-hats
- Ski-gear or other active wear for biking/hiking

WHAT *NOT* TO BRING

- Anything bulky like towels, hair dryers, etc. that the lodging will likely provide
- See the tip above about steaming your attire
- Stress and worry! The best thing is to connect with professional, experienced vendors.
